Community Invited to Breakfast with the Legislators

The Oak Ridge League of Women Voters will hold its first “Breakfast with the Legislators” event of the year on Monday, January 29. The meeting will be held from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. in the Social Room of the Oak Ridge Civic Center, 1401 Oak Ridge Turnpike. A free continental breakfast will be served.

State Senators McNally and Yager, and Representatives Ragan and Calfee have been invited to speak about the legislative outlook for this session of the Tennessee General Assembly, and respond to questions and hear opinions from the audience. The public is invited to attend.

The popular community event offers firsthand information on upcoming legislation and House and Senate committee activities, while prompting dialogue among legislators and citizens, and providing a great networking opportunity for members of the community.

Subsequent 2018 Breakfasts will be held at the same time and place the 4th Monday of each month: February 26, March 26 and April 23, as long as the General Assembly is in session. If the Oak Ridge schools are closed due to inclement weather, Breakfast with the Legislators will be cancelled.
