Lt. Governor McNally, State Senator Yager, and Representatives Ragan and Calfee have been invited to provide a summary of the legislative session of the Tennessee General Assembly, and respond to questions and hear opinions from the audience. The public is invited to attend.

The popular community event offers firsthand information on legislation and House and Senate committee activities, while prompting dialogue among legislators and citizens, and providing a great networking opportunity for members of the community.

These Breakfasts are held at the same time and place the 4th Monday of each month while the General Assembly is in session.
