Making Sense of the Election; topic at Lunch with the League

Since the presidential election, a variety of explanations have emerged for the surprising victory of President-elect Trump. These explanations have addressed demographic, cultural, and political shifts. Dr. Jon Shefner, Head of the Sociology Department, UT Knoxville will examine these explanations, offer his own analysis, and think about the way forward in this new political landscape at Lunch with the League on Tuesday, January 3.
