City Public Works is topic of next Lunch with the League

Shira McWaters will discuss needs, costs and status of upgrades to the City of Oak Ridge's water system at the next "Lunch with the League" program on Tuesday, October 16. McWaters is Director of Public Works for the City.

The meeting will be held from 11:45 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the Social Hall of the *Oak Ridge Unitarian Universalist Church*, located at 809 Oak Ridge Turnpike.

McWaters holds a bachelor's degree in civil engineering from Worcester Polytechnic Institute, and is a certified professional engineer.
