County Executive to speak on the State of Roane County at Lunch with the League

County Executive Ron Woody will give his perspective on issues currently facing Roane County at the next Lunch with the League on Tuesday, February 21. The program will be held from 11:45 a.m. to 1 p.m. in the Social Hall of the Oak Ridge Unitarian Universalist Church, located at 809 Oak Ridge Turnpike.

Woody said he will speak on topics such as Roane County economic development, education, the impact of Legislation, the county jail, and the impending airport. There will be time for questions from the audience following his presentation. .

Woody took office was elected in August 2010. "We've got a lot on the agenda. There's no question," Woody said shortly before taking office in September 2010. Formerly a consultant with the University of Tennessee's County Technical Advisory Service, he is a certified public accountant with years of experience in county fiscal management jobs.
