According to Kennedy, a senior systems engineer for Tetra Tech, he does green energy all over the world for interesting people. He’s been involved in geothermal development in Ethiopia, Tanzania and Uganda, and in big solar for the Navajo Nation. He’s learned their written and spoken languages enough to start bar fights all over the world, too. In his free time, Kennedy is active in geoengineering and has founded two interstellar research start-ups. He is also active with international teams.
